## STUDENT'S RIGHT TO CANCEL

Students have the right to cancel the enrollment and obtain a refund. If written notice of cancellation is made prior to or on the first day of instruction, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later, the institution shall refund all HIS charges, less the deposit or application fee not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100). Cancellation shall occur when the student gives dated, written notice of cancellation at the address of HIS University shown on the cover of this enrollment agreement. The written notice of cancellation, if sent by mail, is effective when deposited in the mail, properly addressed with postage prepaid and need not take any particular form.
